

NEW APPROACHES TO TEACHING: UNIVERSAL DESIGN LEARNING

This course equips learners with the tools to implement the framework and principles of UDL to create more engaging lessons for diverse learners.

COURSE OUTLINE

Unlike most teaching methodology courses, this course emphasizes designing and implementing instructional methods that are more accessible and inclusive regardless of the learner's language proficiency, background knowledge, and level. By exploring a variety of tools for representation (how students take in information), action (how teachers provide Input), and expression (how students produce output), this course provides teachers with strategies to make every aspect of their teaching more equitable and engaging.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Overall objectives of the mobility

- Discover the benefits of the UDL framework and principles
- Learn how UDL can tackle barriers to learning in traditional classrooms
- Create strategies for providing multiple means of representation, action and expression that accommodate diverse learners' needs, preferences and abilities
- Experience flexible assessment options based on the UDL approach
- Reflect on current teaching practices and identify gaps in practicing UDL
- Build a portfolio of different UDL resources

Added value of the mobility

Explore new concepts in teaching while practicing English and sharing experiences with fellow teachers.

Activities to be carried out

- Interactive teaching with input sessions, individual and group tasks
- Skills-focused workshops on developing teaching materials based on UDL principles
- Strategies to aid student expression and make teaching more accessible and inclusive
- Feedback sessions with participants reflecting on their own practice while sharing their knowledge and skills.
- Cultural and heritage trips as part of a chaperoned group

Expected outcomes and impact

This course provides a professional development opportunity to explore an interactive methodology to support creating engaging student-centred lessons in any classroom. Through workshops, group tasks and knowledge-sharing activities, we will look at how Universal Design Learning frameworks can be adapted to create lessons for a diverse group of learners. The opportunity to experience new cultural contexts and network with international colleagues is an added positive outcome.

CULTURAL PROGRAMME

The course is delivered at Atlantic Centre of Education in Galway on Ireland's 'Wild Atlantic' Coast. Participants will have ample opportunity to learn about the cultural heritage of both Ireland and the local area. The week-long programme includes a full-day cultural tour of a local area of scenic and heritage value, a guided historical walking tour of Galway City, and afternoon social and cultural activities.
